

## Parent Request for Exemption from Summative Assessments-A

Per OAR 581-022-1910, a student's parent or guardian may request that a student be excused from a state required program or learning activity, including state testing, to accommodate a student's **disability** or religious belief. The parent must submit the request in writing, listing the reasons for the request and proposing an alternative individualized learning activity for the student that meets the same goals that would be accomplished by participating in state testing.
