

# Bracken School Readiness Assessment (BSRA-4)

The BSRA-4 is a comprehensive assessment used to assess children's understanding of basic concepts including colors, letters, numbers and counting, sizes and comparisons, shapes, and self- and social awareness. Information provided by the assessments is especially important for professionals assessing young children for school readiness. The test is designed to match state standards for early childhood curriculum.

## Administration

- The BSRA-4 is administered using an iPad through the Q-Assess app and the Q-Interactive Dashboard.
- Proctoring the BSRA-4 does not require specific qualifications.
- Completion time: 15-20 minutes
- The assessment is pictorial and does not require children to read other than recognizing letters.
- Scores: School Readiness Composite standard score, percentile ranks, age equivalents, descriptive classifications, and percent correct by subtest
- Proctor instructions are available in Spanish.

## Cost

- The cost for a single license is \$124. This license may be shared across schools as long as two assessments are not being administered at the same time.
- Six subtests will be administered and the base price is \$1.90 per subtest, though for pricing purposes, only three subtests count.
- Total cost per student is \$5.70 for the full administration with a digital score report.
- Subtests do not expire.
