Dear students, parents and staff,

There will be some physical changes to our building as we move through the construction process; we see this as an opportunity to enhance our k-5 educational programing for next school year and beyond. The biggest change our students and staff will experience for the 2017-18 school year is that the gym we currently use will be demolished over the summer to allow construction of the new school. This means that PE, Music, and Library will be held in different spaces.

PE and music programming will be held in the (current) library space and outside – weather permitting. The relocation of PE to the library will not prevent students from receiving physical activity at light, moderate, and vigorous intensities for the same amount of time they had this past school year.

The library will move to an open classroom. The room will include books and several mobile technology carts, so students can continue to explore literature using tangible books as well as accessing digital resources.

Again, we see these minor inconveniences as an opportunity for gain. As we move through the construction process together, please feel free to share your thoughts.
