

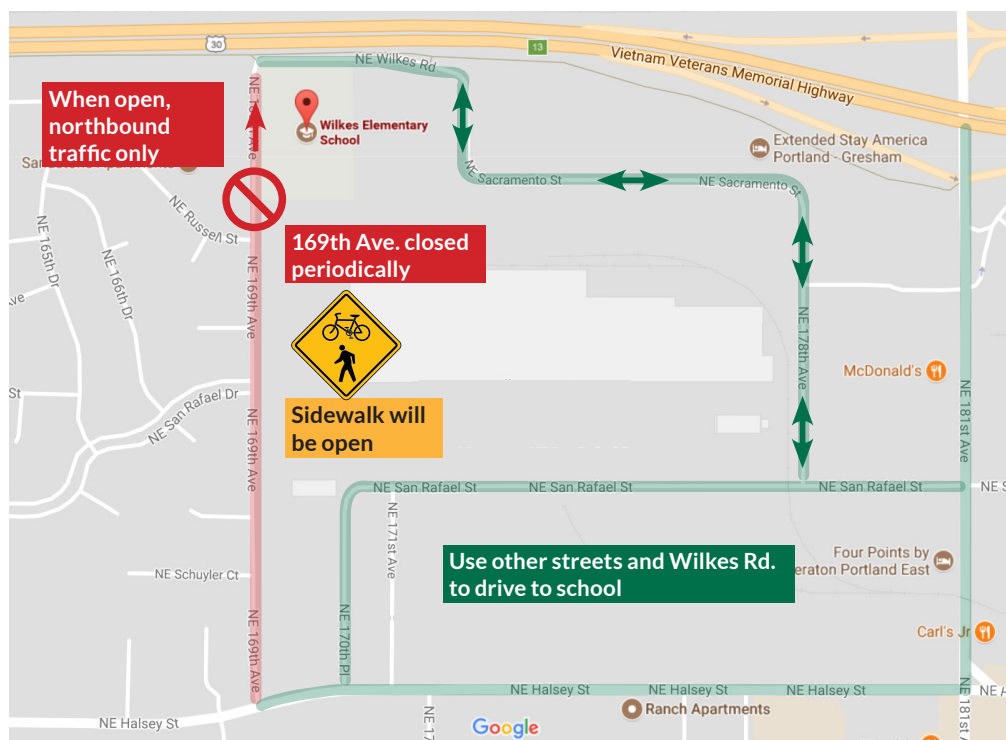

Welcome back, staff and students! Construction is well underway on the new school. Here are some changes you'll notice as construction continues throughout the school year.

TRAFFIC CHANGES: 169TH AVE. TO BE CLOSED PERIODICALLY

To allow construction vehicles to operate safely, 169th Ave. will be closed frequently during the next couple months.

- **169th Ave. will be CLOSED** to all vehicle traffic between Russel St. and the construction area driveway at many times during the day. When 169th Ave. is closed, vehicles must access the school via Wilkes Rd., which will remain open during construction. (See detour routes on reverse.)
- **One lane of 169th Ave. will be OPEN** for pick-up and drop-off traffic during the following hours:
 - Normal school days: 7:45 a.m.– 8:15 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.– 3:15 p.m.
 - Late start days: 8:45 a.m.– 9:25 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.–3:15 p.m.
- Northbound traffic on 169th Ave. will need to continue eastbound along Wilkes Rd. (no southbound on 169th Ave.)
- Bus and parent pick-up and drop-off locations will remain the same.
- We encourage students to ride the bus because parking will be limited to Wilkes Rd. for pick up and drop off. There will be no parking allowed on 169th Ave. during daytime hours.
- The sidewalk on the west side of 169th Ave. will remain open at all times.



OTHER CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

You will notice some changes as you return to school, including:

- 3rd grade classrooms were worked on during the summer, leaving polished concrete floors and new area rugs for students.
- The community use room has been relocated to the library to ensure continued access for SMART readers, Intercambio, Preschool Playgroups, and others.
