Design Work Kicks Off on School Bond Projects

In May 2015, the Reynolds community passed a bond measure to make long-needed improvements to our schools. The bond projects include replacing Troutdale, Fairview and Wilkes Elementary Schools; significantly updating and renovating Reynolds High School; and providing safety and security upgrades to all schools.

Schedule

Work is currently underway to design all of the improvements. Construction will kick off this

summer with safety and security upgrades at Sweetbriar and Salish Ponds Elementary Schools and Reynolds Middle School. Construction on the elementary school replacements and high school updates will begin in the winter of 2016-17. All schools should be move-in ready by fall of 2018.

Local & Diverse Partnership Program

The district wants to provide our local community with training and work opportunities throughout the bond projects. The Local & Diverse Partnership Program was created to provide learning experiences and contracting

assistance to firms, contractors, students, teachers and others. The program will include workshops, technical advice, internships, apprenticeships, mentorships, networking and more.
