Reynolds School District Continues to Offer \$500 Incentives for New Hires

February 22, 2022, Fairview, OR – Reynolds School District will host a job fair at Salish Ponds Elementary School, located at 1210 NE 201st Ave. in Fairview, on Friday, February 25th from 4:00pm to 7:00pm. Reynolds School District is accepting applications for various positions including [Bus Drivers](#), , Educational Assistants, Safety Assistants, [Maintenance Workers](#), [Nutrition Services](#), and [Library Media](#).

On-site interviews will be conducted with conditional offers of employment will be made on the spot when appropriate. New hires in support staff positions will receive a \$500 sign-on bonus, which will be given in full at the end of the 2021-22 school year. New hires will also have access to tuition assistance, fully-paid medical and dental benefits for the employee if hired to work four hours a day or more, and other benefits and opportunities for advancement within the District.

Early online application submissions are encouraged, and there will be laptops and tablets for applicants to submit a job application, print resumes, scan vaccination status and print and sign conditional letters of intent.
