## Student #1

- > Provided opportunities for more physical interaction
- Allowed more preferred activities
- Provided additional adult support
- > Frequent review and revision of behavior plan
- > Family communication plan
- Non-verbal direct attention
- > Change of placement to increase supports

## Student #2

- Increase use of visuals
- > Decrease verbal directions
- Review and revise behavior plan
- Change/modify schedule
- Increase adult support
- Change in adult support
