Steps taken to address use of physical intervention for 2 students exceeding 10 days of restraint:

Student #1

- › Provided opportunities for more physical interaction
- › Allowed more preferred activities
- › Provided additional adult support
- › Frequent review and revision of behavior plan
- › Family communication plan
- › Non-verbal direct attention
- › Change of placement to increase supports

Student #2

- › Increase use of visuals
- › Decrease verbal directions
- › Review and revise behavior plan
- › Change/modify schedule
- › Increase adult support
- › Change in adult support
