



NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO AWARD RFP 2018 E-RATE RSD7 UPSes

Reynolds School District has concluded its assessment of the proposals received for "RFP 2018 E-RATE RSD7 UPSes".

The Committee has selected the following proposer for the award:

MicroK12

Per OAR 137 Division 48, Reynolds School District shall direct negotiations toward obtaining a written agreement on:

- (A) The consultant's performance obligations and performance schedule;
- (B) Payment methodology and a maximum amount payable to the Consultant for the specific services required under the Contract that is fair and reasonable to the Contracting Agency as determined solely by the Contracting Agency, taking into account the value, scope, complexity and nature of the specific services; and
- (C) Any other provisions the Contracting Agency believes to be in the Contracting Agency's best interest to negotiate.

Furthermore,

Reynolds School District shall either orally or in writing, formally terminate negotiations with the highest ranked proposer if the Reynolds School District and Proposer are unable for any reason to reach agreement on a Contract within a reasonable amount of time. Reynolds School District may thereafter negotiate with the second-ranked Proposer, and if necessary, with the third ranked Proposer until negotiations result in a Contract.





Protest of Intent to Award: Adversely-affected or aggrieved Offerors shall have seven (7) calendar days from the date of the Intent-to-Award Announcement within which to file a written protest. Protests submitted after that date will not be considered. Protests must specify the grounds upon which the protest is based.
