

WW II Veteran Requirements

1. They must live in the five county HFPO service area (Clatsop, Columbia, Washington, Multnomah, Hood River).
 2. They must have served in the U.S. military during WW II (Dec. 7, 1941 – Dec. 31, 1946).
 3. They have NOT visited the National WW II Memorial in Washington, D.C. before.
 4. They are physically able to travel. Oxygen and wheelchairs are okay; however, certain medications might restrict or preclude travel.
 5. We encourage a family member to travel with the veteran as their guardian. Their job is to assist one or more veterans. Guardians must be able to push a wheelchair, etc., i.e., they can not require a wheelchair themselves.
- Guardians should apply at the same time veterans apply. Their cost is approximately \$1,200.

What is Honor Flight?

The Honor Flight Network honors our Greatest Generation with an all expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. to see THEIR National WW II Memorial completed in 2004.

We are committed to taking every WW II veteran that is willing and able to go, to see THEIR memorial

Honor Flight volunteer doctors and nurses travel with us on each trip and we do everything in our power to ensure a happy and safe experience for our Heroes.

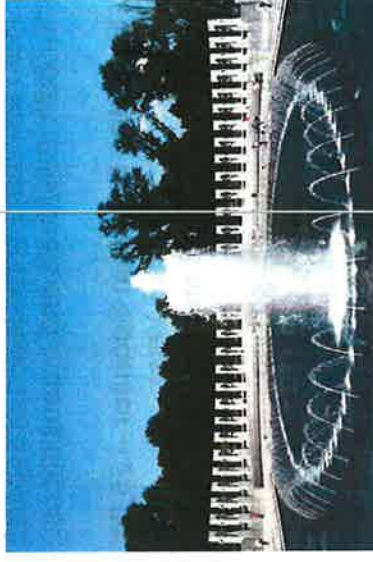

32,100 WW II vets living in Oregon

Oregon loses 40 WW II vets every day

Only 1.2% of Oregon WW II Veterans have visited their memorial through the Honor Flight network.

Only 115 WW II vets from Portland Metropolitan Area have traveled with Honor Flight.

According to the Department of Veterans Affairs, an estimated 640 WW II veterans die each day.

HFPO Plans for 2014

40+ WW II Veterans already on the waiting list

2 trips scheduled – mid-May and mid-September—25 veterans and 25 guardians per trip
