What Happened?

Members of the Public

Public Comment has been shared with the board. Chair Yesenia Delgado thanked all teachers and community members who submitted public comment. *Public Comment is accepted in written form while meetings are virtual. Written comments can be submitted on the School Board's page on the district website.*

Presentation to the Board

Director Ricki Ruiz read the Resolution for Teacher Appreciation Week in its entirety. There was a second reading of the Land Acknowledgement; it will be brought back to the board for a final reading and approval at the next meeting.

Board Reports

The Student Board Representative shared that they are working to celebrate senior athletes who didn't get to participate in their final season, and the student body is working to put together virtual assemblies. Chair Delgado asked board members to review the Virtual Public Meeting Guidelines as a "first reading" and to provide her with any comments or feedback. Board members spoke about their appreciation for Reynolds teaching and nutrition staff. Chair Delgado talked about Budget Committee vacancies and upcoming board meetings.

Superintendent's Reports

For the COVID-19 Update, Dr. Nicole MacTavish discussed the ongoing Distance Learning for All program and new guidelines received for both secondary and elementary students. Dr. Christopher Ortiz spoke about how Student & Family Services is supporting students, families, and staff. Dr. Angela Freeman gave updates on the school principals and the work they are doing. Rachel Lopez Hopper spoke about how Nutrition, Custodial, Transportation, Technology team members have been working to provide meals, keep schools clean, deliver meals and devices, and assist families and staff with technology needs. Rob Neu discussed collaboration with REA and OSEA leadership and plans for reinventing the district's hiring and onboarding processes. Stephanie Field shared how the Communications team has been working to keep families updated on news and provided with customer service support.

Dr. MacTavish discussed Student Achievement and gave information about Kindergarten assessments and the proposed academic calendars. Christina Weinard gave the enrollment report and the financial report. Stephanie Field gave an overview of communications from the last 8 weeks.

For the Superintendent's Action Plan, Rachel Lopez Hopper gave the Facilities Assessment Updates for March and April, Nicole MacTavish presented the Multiyear Professional Development Plan, and Angela Freeman shared the School and Department Improvement Plans.

Action Items

The board approved Resolution 2019-2020-013 Declaring an Emergency and Exemption from the Competitive Bidding Requirements in Response to Governor's Executive Orders Regarding the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. The board took nominations for the name of the new School-Based Health Center, and it was unanimously agreed to name it the Emilio Hoffman Memorial Health Center.
