## What Happened?

### Board Elections

Valerie Tewksbury was voted in as the Board Chair for the 2020-21 school year. Yesenia Delgado was voted in as the Board Vice Chair for the 2020-21 school year.

### Members of the Public

There will be no spoken public comment for virtual meetings, but written comments can be submitted via the online form on the district website. Board Leadership is looking to add spoken public comment for the August board meeting.

### Board Reports

Board members spoke on various topics, including OSBA policies and priorities for the upcoming year and the possibility of bargaining groups having time to speak at board meetings. Board Chair Valerie Tewksbury talked about Budget Committee vacancies and upcoming board meetings.

### Superintendent's Reports

For the COVID-19 update, Dr. Diaz talked about changes to the Operational Blueprint guidance, including equity issues, cohort parameters, the state-wide face covering requirement, and updates to enrollment, attendance and instructional times.

Dr. Nicole MacTavish discussed how schools and departments are working on curriculum, academic programs, and teacher resources. Dr. Christopher Ortiz gave the Operations Update and spoke about working with building staff on furniture needs, PPE, devices, and the hiring of more social workers and counselors. Robert Neu gave the Human Capital Management Update and discussed the filling of 32 positions, working with staff on their options for leave, and collaborating with bargaining groups to work on plans. Stephanie Field gave the Communications report and shared the parent survey results. Christina Weinard gave the July financial report.

### Superintendent's Action Plan

Dr. Ortiz is working on an attendance plan for the upcoming school year to address chronic absenteeism.

### Consent Agenda

It was moved to approve the consent agenda as presented. The board voted and the agenda was approved unanimously. A full list of items that were approved can be found in the board book on the district website.

### Action Items

The board approved the authorization to spend over \$150,000 for student devices and the REA bargaining agreements.
