

Presentation to the Board

RHS assistant principal John Olson and RLA principal Aaron Ferguson spoke to the board about upcoming field trips.

Board Reports

John Lindenthal welcomed everyone to the new school year. Ricki Ruiz discussed the construction of a new mini-pitch at RMS and mentioned the upcoming alumni soccer game. Board Chair Yesenia Delgado talked about the Welcome Back event and announced Budget Committee vacancies.

Superintendent's Reports

Dr. Diaz introduced the new Cabinet members, Dr. Nicole MacTavish and Dr. Angela Freeman. She talked about presenting the Center for Educational Effectiveness data dashboards to Cabinet, continuing the chronic absenteeism initiative, and professional development for Cabinet and RTT. She also discussed three solutions that will be implemented in 2019-20: drafting a comprehensive strategic plan, facilitating a high-quality ELL needs assessment, and performing a facilities assessment to determine facility needs. Finally, Dr. Diaz announced that the school board, the Cabinet, and RTT will all receive equity training throughout the school year.

Christina Weinard, Director of Finance, gave the financial report. Stephanie Field, Director of Communications and Community Relations, spoke about current and upcoming projects.

Consent Agenda

It was moved to approve the consent agenda as presented. The board voted and the agenda was approved unanimously.

Action Items

The board approved spending for substitute services, nutritional and custodial supplies, and RMS field improvements. Grants from the US Soccer Foundation, Amazon, and the Clty of Gresham were accepted. IGAs with PSU, TriMet, Oregon Department of Human Services, Oregon Driver & Motor Vehicles, and MESD were passed; and IGA with the City of Gresham failed to pass. Policies on mother-friendly workplaces, staff with HIV/AICS/HBV, staff hazing and harassment, domestic violence leave, and staff gifts were approved. Upcoming field trips were all approved.
