

WHAT IS THE EASTSIDE TEEN CLINIC?

The Teen Clinic is a primary health clinic just for teens in the Gresham, Barlow, Centennial, David Douglas, Corbett and Reynolds School Districts. It serves youth, ages 12 -19. It treats physical and limited mental health needs at a convenient location adjacent to the Gresham Transit Center.

If you need help, please call or come by the Teen Clinic. We're here to help you.



WHO WORKS THERE?

The Staff at the Clinic includes 4 members: a nurse practitioner, who diagnoses and treats health problems, a community health nurse, an outreach worker, and a medical assistant.

WHAT ABOUT COSTS?

No teen will be turned away for inability to pay. Fees are discounted for students. The Health Department charges for its services based on income and encourages families to be screened for the Oregon Health Plan if they do not have insurance.

CONFIDENTIALITY

A teen's medical record is private and confidential. What you say in a doctor's office is kept private unless the law requires its release. This can be explained at your first visit.

Oregon state law permits teens 15 years and older to consent to their own health care. Oregon law does require a parent or legal guardian's consent to provide medical treatment to an individual *younger than* 15 years. However, a parent's consent is *not* required for services such as STD treatment, birth control and pregnancy testing. Oregon law permits persons of *any* age to obtain these services.

Whenever possible, Teen Clinic staff support and promote parent or guardian involvement in a child's and/or adolescent's health care. Clinic staff encourage parents/guardians to complete health history and consent forms and come to visit when possible.



WHAT SERVICES ARE OFFERED?

- Routine physical exams, including sports physicals
- Diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic illness
- Treatment of minor injuries
- Vision, dental, and blood-pressure screenings
- Age-appropriate reproductive health services, including abstinence counseling, education, exams, and referrals.
- Immunizations
- Health education, and counseling, wellness promotion
- Nutrition education and weight management
- Prescription medications
- Referrals for health care services that are not provided at the Teen Clinic.


Pharmacy Hours:


