I am so excited to share Reynolds School District plans to reopen our schools for full-day, five-day, in-person learning this fall! We have missed our Hornets so much and we are excited to be together again in the building. I understand you may have conflicting feelings about your child returning to school during the pandemic. We have safety precautions in place to keep our community safe. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to me.

Safety Precautions for 2021-22

- Face coverings will be required in all indoor school settings for everyone age 5+ as mandated by Governor Brown and the Oregon Health Authority.
- Face coverings will be required for passengers and drivers on all buses as mandated by the federal government.
- Physical distancing up to 3 feet will continue to be practiced where possible.
- Enhanced cleaning procedures will continue to be followed.

Class Placements

I know everyone is excited to hear about your child's class placement this year! You can log in to your ParentVue account to find out who your child's teacher is. If you need any help accessing your ParentVue account, call the Hartley office. Kindergarteners will be assigned teachers after gradual entry.

During the first couple weeks of school, we will make sure students are placed in their best fit classroom and make changes if needed.

Keeping You Informed

Throughout the school year we will be sharing information, upcoming events and happenings at the school. We have found the best way to communicate with parents is through the FREE Remind App. Remind is a classroom communication tool that makes it easy to stay involved with your child's learning. You can get and send messages on any device—even a simple text from your phone! You can also receive message from the district, such as important news, announcements, and closure information.
