The Graduation Requirements section states which diploma the student is working toward (Standard, Honors, or Modified) and year.

Each graduation diploma category provides an abbreviation of the area, the courses included in that area, the number of credits required to graduate, the number of credits completed, and the remaining credits needed.

This section records the classes, grades and credit for each course taken. Core classes which are required for graduation must have a grade of "D" or higher. Core classes with an "F" do not receive credit and must be retaken through Credit Recovery in order to graduate.
