# Submitted FAFSA/ORSAA... now what?

## NOW THAT YOU HAVE SUBMITTED YOUR FAFSA/ORSAA... HERE ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS.



#### SUBMIT FAFSA/ORSAA

Complete your FAFSA/ORSAA starting **October 1** 

☐ Make sure FAFSA/ORSAA are signed and submitted

Check for an email saying your FAFSA/ORSAA was "Processed Successfully"

Log in to FAFSA to view your Student Aid Report (SAR) and make sure all the information is correct

TIP: If you make any *changes or corrections*, including adding colleges, make sure *you and your parent* sign and submit your FAFSA/ORSAA again.

TIP:Store your and your parent's FSA ID and password somewhere you can easily retrieve it (such as a draft email or in your phone). Create a **student account** for each college you're admitted to

Check your **college email** and **student accounts** early and often to see if you need to complete additional forms

Complete any additional forms and turn them into the college's financial aid office ASAP

NOTE: Being asked to complete additional forms means you were *flagged for verification*. It doesn't mean you did anything wrong; in fact 1/3 of students have to complete additional forms to check their information is correct.

### REVIEW AND ACCEPT AWARDS

Check your college email or student accounts for award letters

Compare all your **financial aid packages.** Discuss which awards to accept or decline with someone you trust or a school counselor.

□ Accept your award offer by your college's deadline. If you need more time, contact your college.

TIP: You don't have to accept all awards your college offers. Always accept *free money* (grants and scholarships) and *earned money* (work study).

You can accept or decline borrowed money (loans).

#### APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Check your college's website for scholarships

Ask your school's college and career center or counselor about scholarship opportunities

TIP: You should never have to pay for a list of scholarships and never pay to apply for a scholarship

Scholarships have different deadlines. Make sure to **check for deadlines** and apply before the deadline.
