
Using Microsoft Translate as a Parent from a Computer




2) Enter the Conversation Code you receive from the teacher in the top bar

Type in your name in the second bar

Select your language in the third bar drop down

Click the green Enter button




3) This is the main conversation page.

Any incoming information will appear on the left.

What you speak, or type will appear on the right.


If the computer asks, allow your computer access your microphone.



To have the program read the translation aloud to you, click the **Wheel** next to your name.

Turn off "Partial Messages" so you will see complete sentences

Turn on "Play Speech Output" so the program will read the text aloud (check that your volume is up)




5) To talk to the teacher, or leader of the conversation:

TYPE into the bar at the bottom of the screen

Click and hold the microphone button and speak clearly into your computer's microphone.
