

WHERE TO GO FOR IMMUNIZATIONS AND RECORDS

If you do not have a record of your child's immunizations:

1. Contact your health care provider's office to see if they have the records.
2. If your health care provider's office does **not** have the records, call other schools or daycare facilities that your child attended.
3. If you still cannot find your child's immunization record, call Multnomah County Health Department, Community Immunization Program, at (503) 988-4724.

If you have the Oregon Health Plan, no insurance, or if your insurance does not cover the full cost of immunizations for your child, you may attend one of the following community clinics:

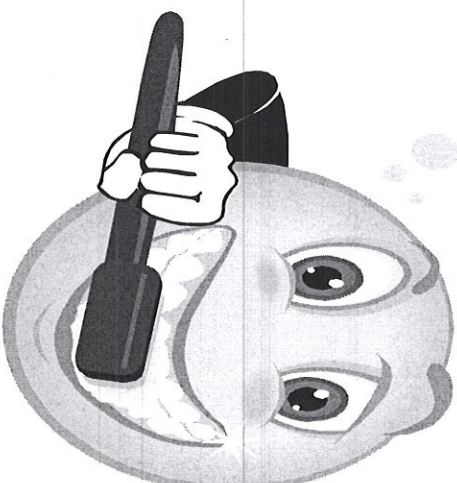

Parent Exemption

Every year students throughout Oregon take state assessments prescribed by the Oregon Department of Education. The purpose of the assessments is to show individual student growth over time and to provide supplementary student-specific data that teachers can use to ensure each and every child is on track to reach goals for college and career readiness.

Oregon state law requires all districts to inform parents that a form is available from the Oregon Department of Education that provides the opportunity to opt your child out of the Smarter Balanced assessments for the 2015-16 school year. The form must be filed annually and is available in 8 languages. Should you choose to opt your child out of providing valuable information about his/her statewide progress in English/Language Arts and/or Math, then please fill out the form found at <http://www.reynolds.k12.or.us/district/2014-15-parent-exemption-guidelines>. Submit the completed form to the District Test Coordinator at 1204 NE 201st Avenue, Fairview, OR 97024, or return the form to your child's school.

Notificación para Padres de Aviso de Exención

Cada año los estudiantes de todo el estado de Oregon toman evaluaciones estatales establecidas por el Departamento de Educación de Oregon. El propósito de las evaluaciones es mostrar el crecimiento individual del estudiante a través del tiempo y proporcionar datos suplementarios específicos de cada estudiante que los maestros pueden utilizar para asegurarse de que cada niño está en camino de alcanzar las metas de preparación universitaria y profesional.

La ley del estado de Oregon requiere que todos los distritos informen a los padres que hay un formulario disponible del Departamento de Educación de Oregon que ofrece la oportunidad de excluir a su hijo/a de las evaluaciones Smarter Balanced para el año escolar 2015-16. El formulario debe completarse anualmente y está disponible en 8 idiomas.
