Mondays are a late start to allow staff time to learn and collaborate for student success. The rest of the week allows for more student learning time. Please note the new start times for this school year. Arrival and dismissal times are:

Mondays 10:15am – 3:50pm

Tuesdays to Fridays 9:05am – 3:50pm

There is a 15-minute arrival and breakfast period. Students will be recorded as late after 10:30am on Mondays and 9:20am on Tuesdays through Fridays. Please make sure students arrive on time so they can eat breakfast and connect with their classmates. Morning time is a time to check in with each other and build community, and we don't want them to miss it!
