Goal/Event/Strategy:

1. Goal- Clear Communication Between Parent, Teacher, and Student/ Increase Accessibility to Resources/Event-Fall Parent Teacher Conferences/ Strategy- Teachers provide parents access with on-line resources such as Reading Eggs, Math Seeds, and Mobymax to enhance personalized learning at home. These programs provide data to formatively guide the student, parent, and teacher with educational program planning.
2. Goal- Develop an action plan to shape conditions and form habits that promote successful academic home routines/ Event- Teachers will communicate to students and parents the importance of reading at home and incentivize strong reading habits through a step system.Strategy- Throughout the year students will read for 30 minutes to earn steps. Data will be tracked by teachers to monitor student progress. Additionally, we will continue to give students free books at events such as Open House and Art Night.
3. Goal- Help parents to keep their children reading throughout the school year/Event- K-5 Spring Partnership with theMultnomah County Library/Strategy- To provide parents with an opportunity to explore the library as a resource for finding a wide-range of engaging and interesting books
