1. Abbreviations for Strands:

English Language Arts

- RL Reading Literature
- RI Reading Informational Text
- W Writing
- L Language
- SL Speaking and Listening
- 2. Each Strand has its own section on the Standards Document.
- 3. English Language Arts Example:
 - a. My child(ren)'s Progress Report has this written: 6.RI.4
 - b. What does it mean?
 - 6 = the grade (Sixth Grade)
 - RI = the strand (Reading Informational Text)
 - 4 = the standard number
 - c. Ok, now what do I do?
 - 1. Go to Sixth Grade
 - 2. Open the English Language Arts Standards
 - 3. Scroll down to Reading Informational Text
 - 4. Find Standard #4
 - d. That is the standard being assessed on the assignment that reads 6.RI.4.
- 3. Social Studies Example:
 - a. My child(ren)'s Progress Report has this written: 7.4

- b. What does it mean?
 - 7 = the grade (Seventh Grade)
 - 4 = the standard number
- c. Ok, now what do I do?
 - 1. Go to Seventh Grade Social Studies
 - 2. Open the Social Studies Standards
 - 3. Scroll down to Standard #4
- d. That is the standard being assessed on the assignment that reads 7.4.
