## WHAT WILL SCHOOL BE LIKE THIS FALL?

- Students will still have a schedule with seven classes and a Homeroom class each term.
- They will have 4 periods and homeroom every day.

## SPRING 2020 VS FALL 2020

### **These things will stay the same:**

- All class work will be available 24/7 in Schoology.
- All students will have a school issued iPad.
- Students will complete their schoolwork at home on the iPad
- Students will be able to email, text and call their teachers and other school staff to ask questions and get help.

## SPRING 2020 VS FALL 2020

### **These things will be new/different:**

- Students will have a regular class schedule where they will be expected to log-in and participate in live classes **where they will get to see and interact with their teachers and classmates on a regular basis.**
- Teachers will have regularly scheduled times, outside of class, when they will be available to answer questions and provide support to students working on assignments so it will be easier for students to get the help they need.
- Students will earn regular letter grades instead of pass/incomplete.
- All Reynolds School District students, Kindergarten through High School, will have their own district issued computer or iPad so that students won't have to share their device with a sibling.
- This time, we are ready.

## HOW YOU CAN HELP?



Do what you can to make sure your child is up and logged into class at 8:30 AM each day. If you are not at home, a daily text check-in is a good idea.



Make sure your child has a quiet place where they can participate in video meetings and do classwork between 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM each day.



Check your child's grades and attendance in ParentVUE at least once a week. Call, text or email us if you have concerns.



Make sure you are signed up for Remind and that you check the email address we have on file for you regularly.
