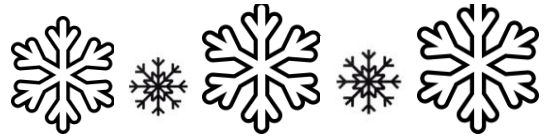
LOST & FOUND!
