Dear Woodland Families,

I hope this note finds you well.

March is a busy month for school, we are well into our second semester and conferences are coming up on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. Please don't feel like those are the only times you can reach out to your child's teacher. It can always be helpful to make a phone call or write an email to ask how your child is doing, or to share information that may help us better serve them.

Like last year, the statewide tests for students in grades 3-5 will begin in April. Before the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> graders take the Smarter Balanced assessment you and your student can view the practice test at this website - <http://sbac.portal.airast.org/practice-test> or you can find it by typing "SBAC practice" into your search engine and click the top link. This will give you and your student a chance to see what the assessment is like and practice for preparation for the actual assessment in April and May.

Regardless of what grade your child is in, one of the best things you can do to help them in school to read each night. Students love time to read independently, but they also love being read to, or having family reading time. When students are able to read on or above grade level by the end of third grade, which is when kids transition from *learning to read* to *reading to learn*, they are three to four times more likely to graduate high school and attend college, post-graduate, or professional development classes.

Bring your kindergarten-age child to tour their school and have some fun while registering for kindergarten!

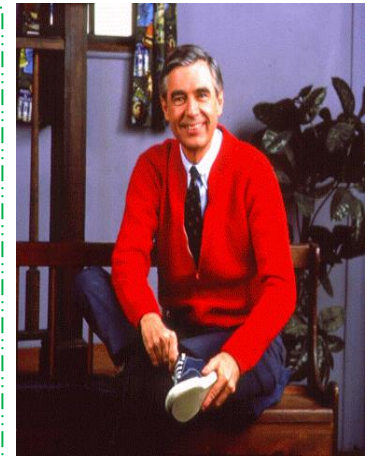
Students should be five years old by September 1st, 2020 to register.

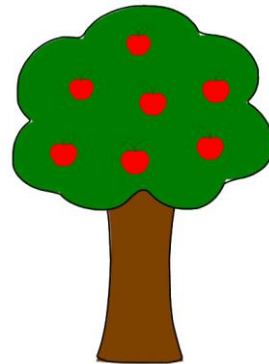

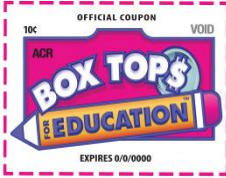
