Safety in the Parking Lot




Woodland Families, I'd like to remind you of a few **safety** steps for our parking lot.

Please remember our goal in the lot is to keep everyone, *especially kids*, **safe**.

- **DRIVE SLOWLY**-Students who walk use the sidewalk on that side and unexpected things do happen in the parking lot and driveways.
- Please drop off children at the drop-off area.
- For everyone's **safety** students should not walk through the parking lot.
- If you walk in with students, please keep them at your side and watch for other cars.
- Stay out of the way of the busses-the bus always has the Right of Way.
- Park only in designated spaces, not in between the parking spots.
- When picking up, students must be picked up from the pick-up area, it is not **safe** to have them walk across traffic to the parking areas.
- When exiting the parking lot, both lanes are *right turn only*. Turning left creates a back up in the lot, it is difficult for traffic to flow correctly, and the buses cannot turn out from the parking lot.

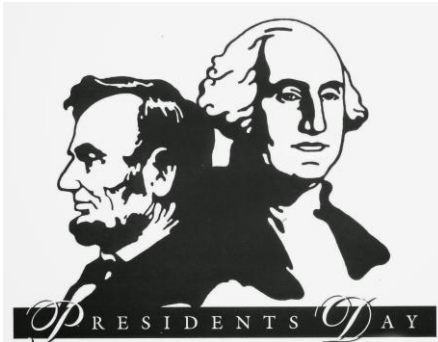

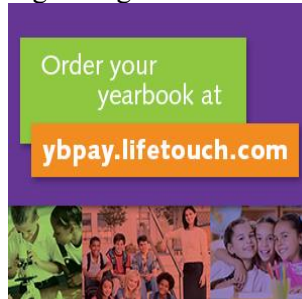

Too Sick for School?

Students can go to school if:

- They have a runny nose or little cough, but no other symptoms.
- They haven't taken any fever reducing medicine for 24 hours and have been fever-free during that time.
- They haven't thrown up or had diarrhea for 24 hours.

Too Sick for School?

Keep Students home if:

- They have a temperature higher than 100.5 degrees even after taking medicine.
- They are throwing up or have diarrhea.
- Their eyes are pink and crusty.

Call the doctor if:

- They have a temperature higher than 100.5 degrees for more than two days.
- They've been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than two days.
- They've had the sniffles for more than a week and aren't getting better. These are generally accepted guidelines. Everybody is different. If you are unsure, ask your health care provider or call your school.
