#### Safety in the Parking Lot-



Woodland Families, I'd like to remind you of a few safety steps for our parking lot.

Please remember our goal in the lot is to keep everyone, especially kids, safe.

- Drive **slowly** in the lot. 5 mph is plenty.
- Please drop off children at the drop off site. For everyone's safety, students should not walk through the parking lot.
- If you walk in with students, please keep them at your side and watch for other cars.
- Park only in designated spaces, not in between the parking spots.
- When picking up, students must be picked up from the pick-up area, it is **not safe** to have them walk across traffic to the parking areas.
- When exiting the parking lot, both lanes are *right turn only*. Turning left because this creates a back-up in the lot, it is Difficult for traffic to flow correctly, and the buses cannot turn out from the parking lot.
- For safety reasons, the buses have the right of way in the parking lot.
  By not turning left to exit, you'll also help the buses deliver students home safely, and on time.

It's getting darker in the morning, let's keep the kids safe!
