Safety in the Parking Lot-



Woodland Families, I'd like to remind you of a few safety steps for our parking lot.

Please remember our goal in the lot is to keep everyone, especially kids, safe.

- Drive **slowly** in the lot. 5 mph is plenty.
- Please drop off children at the drop off site. For everyone's safety, students should not walk through the parking lot.
- If you walk in with students, please keep them at your side and watch for other cars.
- Park only in designated spaces, not in between the parking spots.
- When picking up, students must be picked up from the pick-up area, it is **not safe** to have them walk across traffic to the parking areas.
- When exiting the parking lot, both lanes are **right turn only**. Turning left because this creates a back-up in the lot, it is Difficult for traffic to flow correctly, and the buses cannot turn out from the parking lot.
- For **safety** reasons, the buses have the right of way in the parking lot. By not turning left to exit, you'll also help the buses deliver students home **safely**, and on time.



It's getting darker in the morning, let's keep the kids safe!
