Hello Woodland Families,

I am thankful to be a part of helping your children grow, and I'm especially thankful they get to thrive with the help of our amazing Woodland community.

I want to take a moment to thank you for being our partner in helping your sons and daughters grow into caring, thoughtful, kind people. Your support and help have been critical in switching to Distance Learning—thank you. We know learning from home is tough on everyone, and we want to remind you that if a child is using their computer or iPad, that likely the camera or their mic is on. Because your home is now part of the classroom, it is very important that all members of your family realize that everyone in class can see what is happening in the background of your student's screen. They can also hear what is being said in the home when children are unmuted. Please ask all family members to know that your child's mic and camera are on during distance learning, and make sure all conversations and anything happening behind the student are school appropriate. Thank you for helping keep our school environment safe for everyone.






We now have an opportunity for you to pick up learning tools and supplies every **Wednesday**. We'll hand them out between **8:00 and 10:00** in the morning and again between **3:00 and 5:00**. You may also pickup any needed supplies if you come in to pick up lunches. Please only come in if your child's teacher lets you know that there are supplies for pickup. Not every teacher will have something to pick up each week.

We have conferences coming up at the end of the month, and we hope to see you there. Please be sure to check with your child's teacher for more information.

On a separate note, we also have some help available for the holidays for our families who need it. If you're in need of some assistance either with food or gifts, please contact our Counselor, Mrs. Astrella, or our Care Team, as soon as possible.

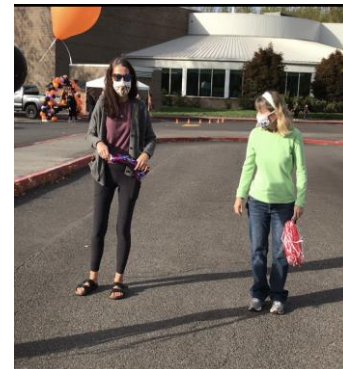
